Daisy (Year 2) for being kind and caring all week. **Lola (Year 3)** for showing kindness and encouragement to others.

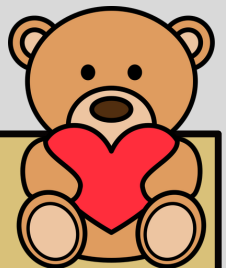
