Welcome back to St Joseph's! I do hope that you have all had an enjoyable summer. As you know, despite me being on site over the holidays, some of the planned works have not yet been completed. Today, the contractors have installed a security system for the front gate. We are very pleased that this has been installed as children and adult safety in school is of the highest priority. Thank you for your patience with the locked gate and contacting the office. The gate will be completed shortly, as we are still awaiting the intercom, so that you can buzz to be allowed to enter the school. On Monday, please wait at the gate and the office staff will let you in. I hope to be able to give you a further update on the cladding for the EYFS outside area and the bi-folding door in between Year 3 and Year 4 classrooms, next week.

It has been delightful to see all the children back at school, looking smart and behaving impeccably - thank you for ensuring that the children are wearing the correct school uniform. I know there has been a problem with supplies of some of the girl's uniform, we are exploring a range of options to overcome this. I would like to remind you that at break time, the children are allowed a healthy snack - crisps, croissants, cake bars, cakes, biscuits, chocolate and many cereal bars are not healthy snacks. In addition to this, I would also like to remind you that we are a nut free school. This is because we have children in school who have both airborne and contact severe allergies to nuts. For these reasons, adults will not allow children to eat these foods. If your child has a SEND or medical reason to eat unhealthy foods, please let me know. All children in Pre-School, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are offered a piece of fruit at break time.

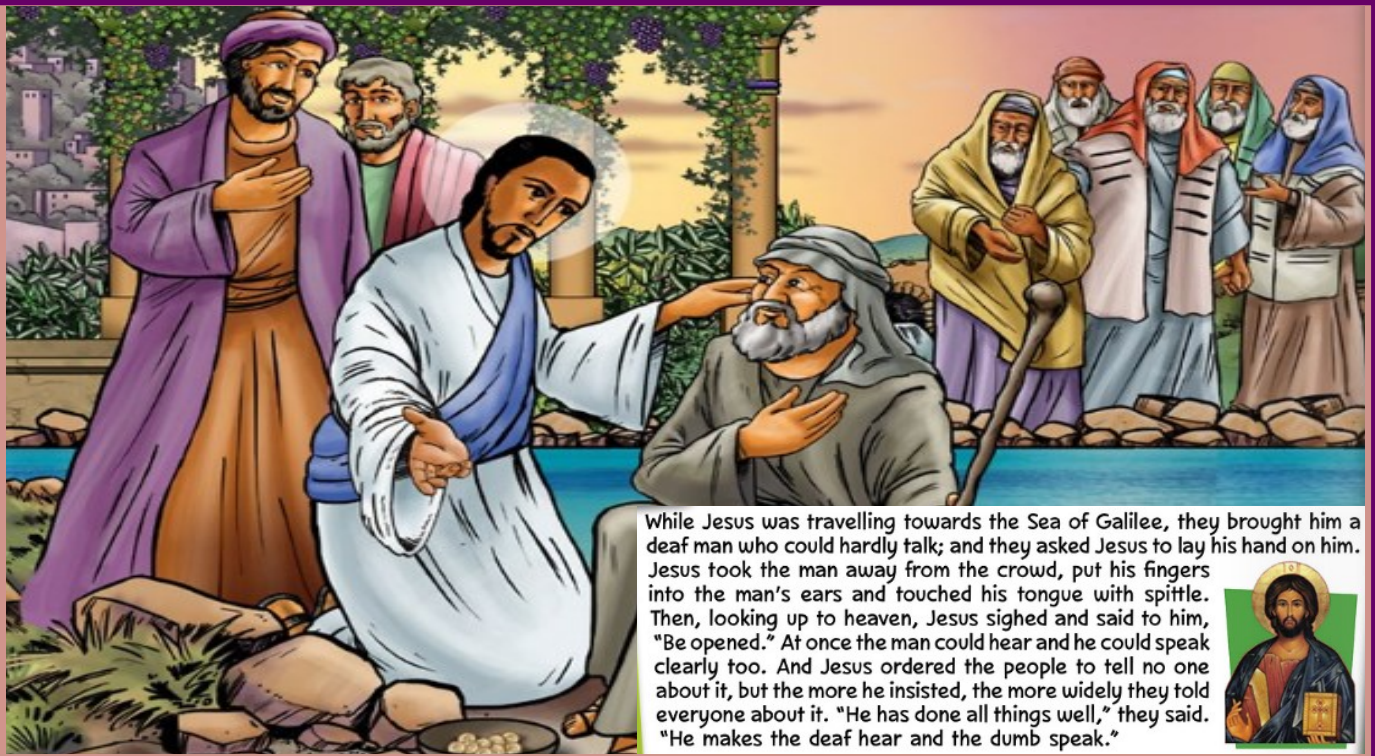

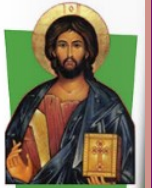
