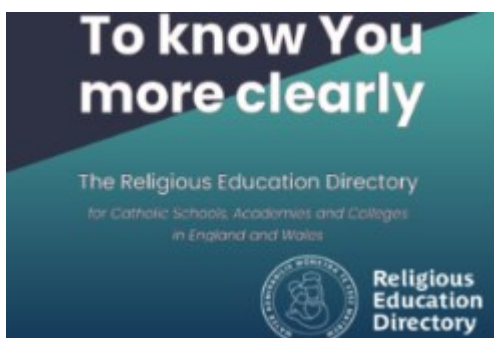
Catholic Life and Mission at St Joseph's

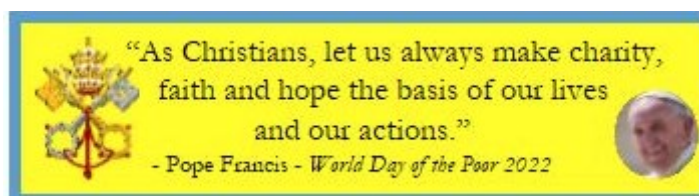
Religious Education at St Joseph's

Creation and Covenant

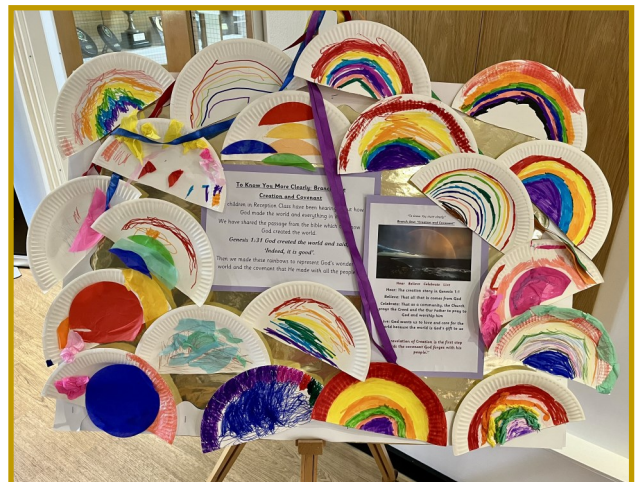
The children in Reception Class have been hearing about how God made the world and everything in it.

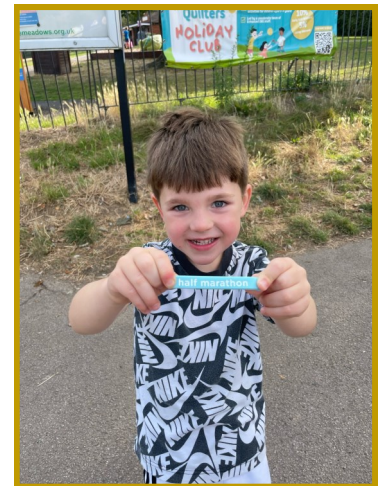
