Isaac (Yr6) and Amelia (Yr6) for smoothly running all the music for the nativities this week.

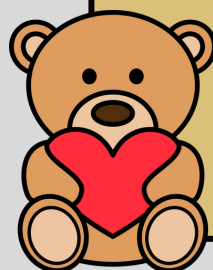

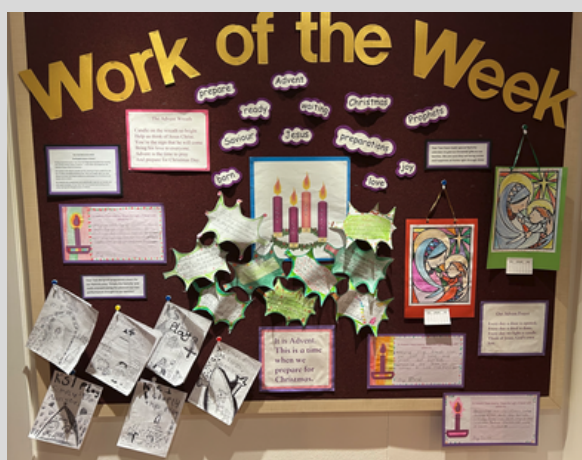
Terrific Teddy

Year 2 have been learning about the customs and meaning of Advent.

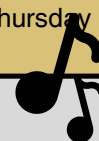

Dear Parents/carers,

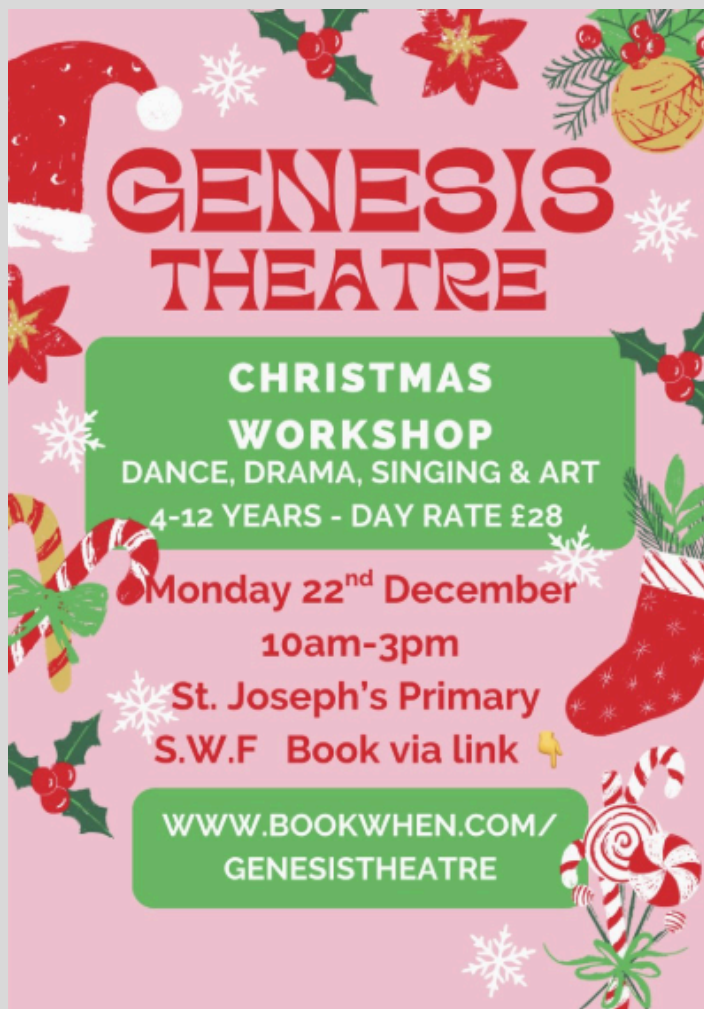
After 20 years working at St Joseph's, it is my time to move on and help other children. I no longer live close to the school, so the commute has forced my hand.
