

Year 3: Finley, for his excellent contributions in lessons this week. It has been lovely to see him sharing his knowledge with the class. Well done!


Year 4: Sena, for her excellent focus and listening in lessons. She has approached Year 4 with a very mature attitude. Well done!


Notices

Introducing: **PianoFunClub**

At **PianoFunClub** we believe that every child should have the opportunity to play music, and we would love to know if the following music programme would be of interest .

We are offering your child the chance to learn the **Piano, Guitar or Violin** during school hours. Lessons are open to all children and would be arranged by PianoFunClub starting from next term.

All lessons would be taught by visiting professional tutors with all teaching material provided, full identification, and a full DBS.

Each pupil will receive 10 lessons per term - lessons are booked in and paid for at the beginning of every new term and half term.

Instruments for school lessons will be provided by PianoFunClub
(You will have the opportunity to have an instrument to keep at home for a £50.00 deposit)

Stage 1 lessons: 20 minute paired lesson weekly £42.00 per half term

Stage 2 lessons: 20 minute individual lesson weekly £84.00 per half term

Stage 3 lessons: 30 minute individual lesson weekly £126.00 per half term
