Headteacher Weekly Message

It has been a lovely week in school, celebrating the last school week of the Advent season. I would like to say a huge thank you to all the parents who have helped out in school – reading with children, sewing with the children, helping on trips and workshops and supporting the PTA with the Christmas Bazaar. It has made school feel like a school and home community.

Over the holidays, we will be having some more work completed to improve the school grounds. There will be cladding put along the whole of the fence that runs from the playground to the field. Additionally, we are having the Office partitioned into three sections so that there is a working space for all staff. This work is being carried out using Capital funding. This funding is ringfenced and cannot be used to employ another teacher. We are still awaiting the bi-fold doors for Year 3 & 4 classrooms, there has been another delay on this part of the project. I will let you know as soon as we have an update on this.

As you know, from January 2025, we are able to offer a full time Pre-School provision. Please can you share this information far and wide so that we can continue to grow our school. One of the significant reasons why we have our deficit budget is because of low numbers of pupils. We hope that by extending our Pre-School offer, we can start to get more children in for the upcoming Reception classes. We are still pursuing funding to start up an after school club so that we cater effectively for working families.
